

Exercises for functions

Exercise 1

Define a Function named `hello()` that doesn't take any parameters.

```
function hello() {  
  
}
```

When called `hello()` write 3 times HELLO WORLD with heading 2.

Then test your `hello()` function by making a link that calls it.

```
<a href="#" onclick = "hello();" > test hello function </a>
```

Exercise 2

Define a Function `hello3(name)` that take one string parameter .

```
function hello3(name) {  
  
}
```

When called `hello3('Tim')` the function write 3 times Hello Tim with heading 1 styled with red color and veranda font.

The test your Function by calling it in your script e.g.

```
hello3("Tim"); hello3("Tim Berners Lee"); hello3("Mom");
```

Exercise 3

Make a webpage that have 2 links and 1 button.

Link 1: opens an alert box

Link 2: opens your favorite webpage in a new window.

Button 1: opens a prompt where the user can enter their name. After clicking ok the name shall be Written to the document by using the `hello3(name)` function from exercise 2.
